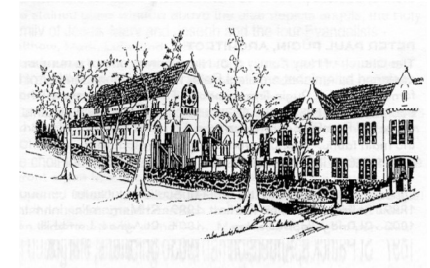

## Census 2022

Recently, more Census 2022 information was published. Some of the information is interesting and useful for our parishes.

1323 people were counted living in **Twechar** and the number of those identifying as Catholics was **254**.

8291 were counted as living in **Lenzie** and **1161** said they were Catholics.

In **Auchinloch**, 852 people were counted living there and **126** identified as Catholics.

The total figure counted In **Kirkintilloch** was 22037 and of them **4853** counted themselves as Catholics.

Therefore, there appears to be around 250 Catholics in St John of the Cross Parish, Twechar. We counted 50 people at Mass in the parish on the first Sunday of November 2023 and about 105 on Christmas Day and 75 on Easter Sunday 2024.

There are around 3070 Catholics living in St Flannan's parish. 301 were counted at Mass on the first Sunday in November 2023, approximately 900 at Mass at Christmas and about 400 at Mass at Easter.

There are approximately 3070 Catholics living in Holy Family and St Ninian's parish. 557 were counted at Masses in the parish on first Sunday in November 2023, approximately 900 at Christmas and 850 at Easter.
